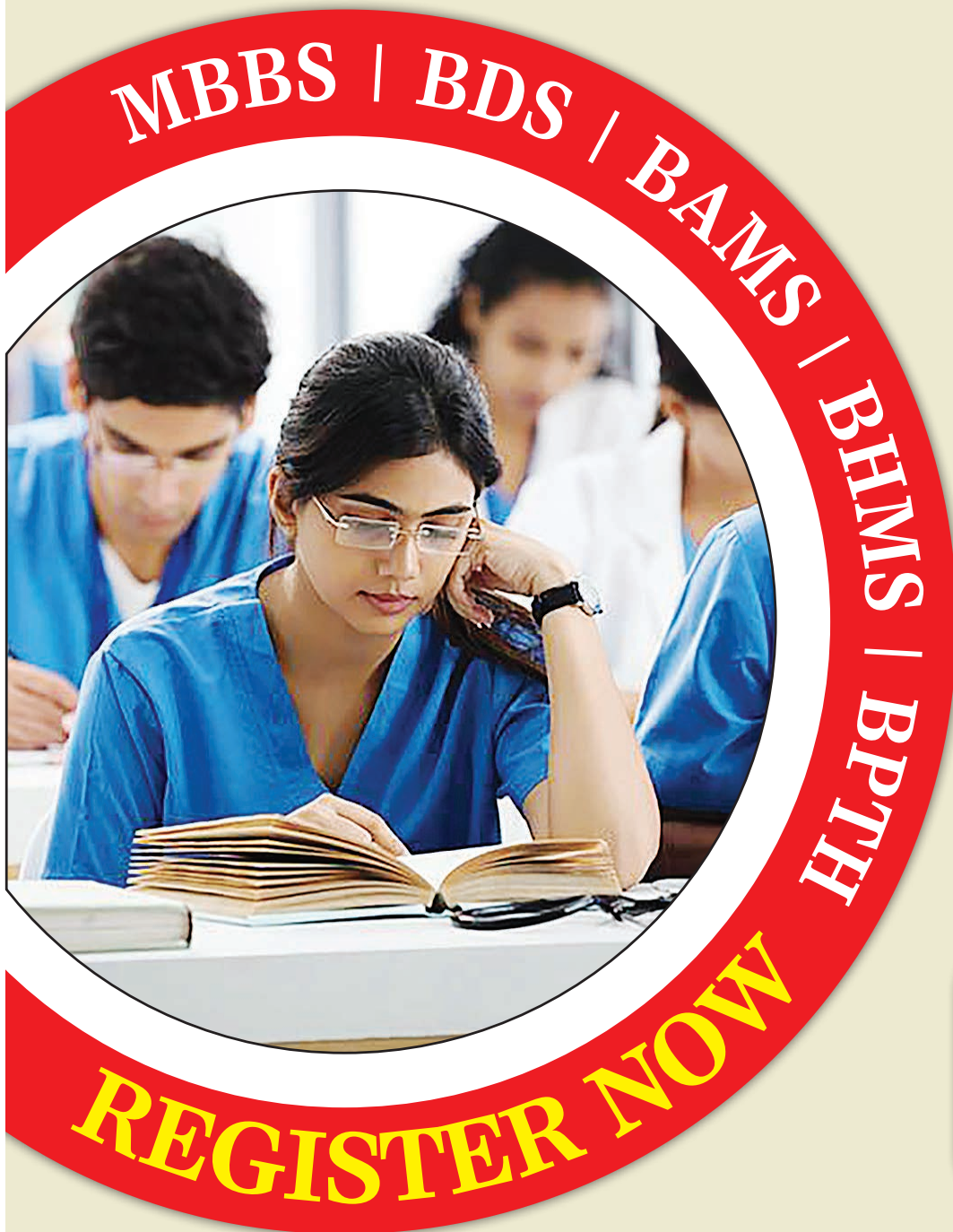

- Prepares reports for government or management of birth, death, and disease statistics, workforce evaluations, or medical status of individuals.

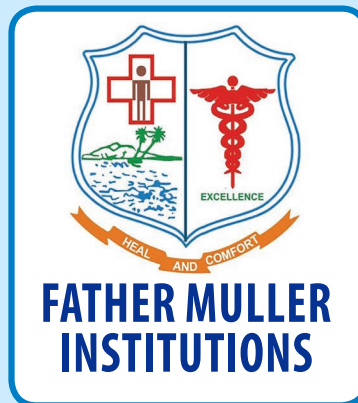

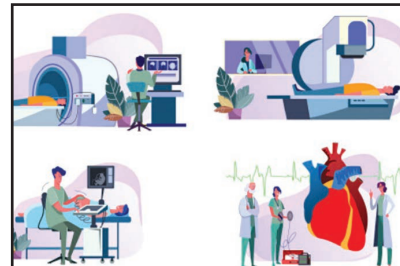

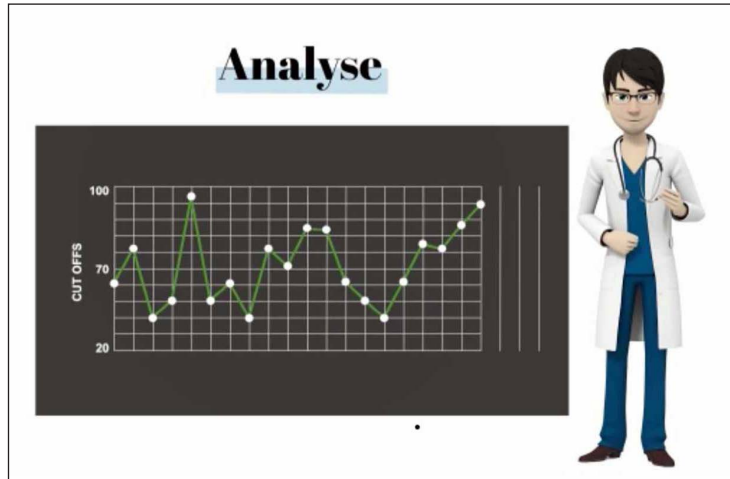

Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu India has predicted that with increased digital adoption,

the Indian healthcare market, which is worth around US\$ 100 billion, will likely grow at a CAGR of 23 per cent to US\$ 280 billion by 2020. The healthcare market can increase three fold to US\$ 372 billion by 2022. India is experiencing 22-25 per cent growth in medical tourism and the industry is expected to double.
